

# Certificate III in Occupational Health & Safety Course (BSB31606)

## Flexible Delivery 2007 (Group Booking Only)



This course is designed to provide a comprehensive understanding of OHS in the workplace, and is ideal for Health and Safety Representatives or to provide additional skills in the field of OHS. The course designed to satisfy most of the requirements for the Foreman/ Supervisor as per the **Construction Safety Competency Framework**.

There are no prerequisites for this course, however participants are required to have:-

- sufficient level of numeracy and literacy
- comprehend instruction to reference, understand legislation, standards and codes of practice and consult with workers and employers on safety issues.

Successful participants will receive a Certificate III in OH&S. Participants who complete individual units will receive a Statement of Attainment for those units and those who attend the courses but do not complete course work and assessments will receive a Statement of Attendance.

- (A) 3 days Face-to-Face for units BSBOHS301A, 302A, 303A, 304A, 305A, 306A and BSBOHS307A  
**PLUS** (B) 1 day Face-to-Face for units BSBCMN301A, 304A and 305A and BSBFLM303B  
**PLUS** (C) completion of \*MNMG237A and/or \*\*PMAPER205B and /or PMAPER200C (other units may satisfy)  
**PLUS** (D) course work and assessment activities required for participants who will need access to a workplace to enable competency of learning and assessment activities.
