

Maurie Curwood Fellowship Awards Selection Criteria 2008



The Maurie Curwood Fellowship Awards were established to recognise individual endeavours and create and maintain linkages with the community and industry, as well as fostering partnerships that reflect the role of Swinburne TAFE in the local community.

The Award

The Fellowship Award of \$2000 is presented annually and is open to all staff of Swinburne's TAFE Division, including support staff, teaching staff and managers.

The Award is to be used to support the professional development of an individual staff member. It is designed to give the recipient the opportunity to step outside and enhance what is normally done in everyday roles and move forward in terms of flexible delivery, community and/or industry support or liaison.

Staff members may self-nominate or be nominated by any other interested person.

Selection Criteria

Fellowship Awards recognise community contribution, involvement and/or commitment as a key selection criterion. Applicants must address three of the four selection criteria below:

1. Clear benefit and ongoing commitment to local or regional community and/or industry that builds towards sustainable activity.
2. Innovation and initiative in identifying and meeting the needs of a key client group – either an internal customer or external in the community/industry.
3. An impact on the organisation that contributes to the mainstream adoption or administrative support of flexible delivery strategies.
4. Consistency with the strategic directions of Swinburne TAFE and a contribution to the realisation of those directions (mandatory).

- Application is signed off by Department Manager, nominator (if applicable), nominee and referees
- Application submitted to the Centre for Engagement in Vocational Learning by 24 July 2009

- Cover sheet
- Response to three of four key criteria – providing demonstrable evidence to satisfy the criteria (maximum two pages)
- Proposal for Fellowship program – details of how Fellowship to be used (one page)
- Applicant's and referees' signatures (if transmitted electronically must include supporting email)
- Supplementary information (two pages maximum)
